Welcome to the second annual 8-to-8 event: four dances entirely conceived, created, and rehearsed within 24 hours. We didn't pioneer the "let's make a show in 24 hours" idea, but the community energy for the 8-to-8 is making it an instant favourite dance and physical theatre event. Here's how the process has gone so far:

At 8:00 pm Saturday night, four visual artists arrived at a downtown school space, each with a line or two of text. They swapped the pieces of text, and then each created a visual art piece based on the text they received. The four choreographers arrived at 11:00 pm to negotiate which of the pieces would inspire their dance work. At 8:00 am this morning, over two dozen performers and musicians met at the Market Hall to warm up and be cast in the four works. Rehearsals have taken place throughout the day in empty classrooms, during which the lighting set up took place at the Market Hall. Each group has had 45 minutes for a dress and technical rehearsal, the last of which ended less than an hour before the show you will see tonight. We can't wait to see what this creative pressure-cooker has produced!
