THE QUEEN OF PARADISE'S GARDEN

The Queen of Paradise's Garden is a tale from the oral tradition. It exists in various forms in stories all over the world. Today's re-telling of the tale is based on a version told by Albert Heber Keeping of Grand Bank Newfoundland. Mr. Keeping's words were tape-recorded in 1965 by Herbert Halpert and Ronald Noseworthy. A transcript of that recording was published in the 2 volume Folktales of Newfoundland by Herbert Halpert and John Widdowson, and was the basis for the adaptation by Andy Jones and Darka Erdelji.
