CALL FOR POP-UP PERFORMANCES

LOOKING FOR THEATRE, DANCE & PERFORMANCE ARTISTS

- *Are you an artist - or group of artists - with a new or existing site specific performance?*
- *Do you have an idea for a pop-up performance?*

Application deadline: 5pm, April 24th 2019

In celebration of our 25th Anniversary, Public Energy Performing Arts is seeking performing artists from the Peterborough/ Nogojiwanong area to create short POP-UP PERFORMANCES in the downtown area.

Pop-Up Performances will take place throughout the afternoon of **May 25th 2019** in locations such as businesses, storefronts, and shared public spaces. Each performance should be approx. 10-15 minutes in length (flexible) and be able to be performed twice throughout the afternoon. Successful applicants will be notified by April 26th.

How participants are selected:

Participants will be selected based on artistic vision, viability of the project, and use of site. Successful projects will receive an honourarium between \$250-\$600, depending on project size.

What to send us:

- **Project Description & Technical Requirements** One page (max). Describe your project including names of artistic collaborators, stage of development (re-mount or new?), desired location and list your technical requirements (sound, etc.). It is not necessary for you to have a chosen venue location, but if you have one in mind please include it and why it would work for your project.
- **Artist Bio** of principal artist(s). The principal artist - or one of them, if a group - must be a resident of the Peterborough/Nogojiwanong area (Peterborough City, County, and area First Nations).
- **Support Material:** Provide minimum one of: video or audio (5 min max), images (5 max), script (5 pages max.) Support material can be from current or previous work – please indicate clearly. Video or images can be attached or submitted online via a link to a web site.

Deadline: 5 pm, April 24, 2019
