What is the Peterborough Memorial Centre?

The Peterborough Memorial Centre is a 4,329-seat multipurpose arena in Peterborough, Ontario, Canada. Built in1956, it is now home to the Peterborough Petes of the Ontario Hockey League and the Peterborough Lakers of the Major Series Lacrosse league.

The Peterborough Memorial Centre is a single-pad arena. It is named in honour of the many war veterans who came from the region.



Getting Here

The Peterborough Memorial Centre is located at 151 Lansdowne St, Peterborough, ON K9J 1Y4. Right next to the RA Morrow Memorial Park. The Peterborough Transit Bus Stop is located right outside the building on Lansdowne St W.



Accessible Parking

The Peterborough Memorial Centre has accessible parking near the front entrance. Additionally, there is van accessible drop off roundabout at the front of the building.

Accessible Parking, entrance is on your left.





Van accessible drop off, entrance is straight ahead on your left.

Stair-Free Accessible Navigation of Peterborough Memorial Centre (Balcony)



From Accessible Parking, proceed forward to entrance.

Enter pull door, or use accessible button on your left.





For putinckets, proceedraight ahead.



Box Office is on your right.




From main entrance, proceed to left door to enter pull door, or use accessible button on your right. 8



From the main entrance lobby, to access the elevator, turn left.



Proceed to elevator.




Enter elevator, push button on left.



Within elevator, button panel is on your right. Click the 2nd floor button.

Upon exiting the elevator, proceed to your right.






Accessible Seating is located along the balcony. Closest seats are a row of folding chairs (pictured) 1

Additional seats are cushioned and moveable with arm and back rests.

Navigation of Peterborough Memorial Centre (Ground Floor, some stairs required)



From Accessible Parking, proceed forward to entrance.

Enter pull door, or use accessible button on your left.





For purchasing tickets, proceed straight ahead.

Box Office is on your right.






From main entrance, proceed to left door to enter pull door, or use accessible button on your right. 13



From the main entrance lobby, to enter the arena proceed to entrance "to Sections 19-18-16-14" indicated by sign above doorway.

Enter arena, there are four steps up to reach seating area.






Proceed to the right to accessible seating area.



Continue right towards seating area, there are additional steps 4 along the way.

Foldable stationary seating is located along the base of the arena. There are also hard foldable chairs available.







Accessible Restroom (First Floor)



For the first floor accessible restroom, at the main lobby turn right.

Proceed to the left past the Petes Merchandise Store.





The accessible restroom is the door between the fire extinguisher and the blue bulletin board.

Press the accessible button on your right. (Note that you must push the button to open the door)





Enter the accessible restroom.




To access the second floor accessible washroom from the 2nd floor elevator proceed to the right.

Approach the accessible seating area sign located above the accessible restroom doorway.





Turn to your left to access the door. Press the accessible button on your right to enter.



Enter the accessible restroom.


Accessible Restroom (First Floor alternate)



For the first floor restroom, at the main lobby turn left.


Proceed down the lobby.





Turn right once you reach the staircase.


The accessible restroom is on your right. Use the accessible button on the right to open the door.





You have arrived at the accessible restroom.





From the main lobby, the ATM is located straight ahead toward the right.

Water Refill Station



From the main lobby, the Water Refill Station is located straight ahead toward the left.

You have arrived at the Water Refill Station.



Quiet Zone

To access the quiet zone, proceed to the right from the main entrance. The quiet zone is located in front of the Corner Bar. Sensory toys and sound and light dampening equipment will be located on a table in the vicinity, and can be borrowed as needed.
